WOBA 2018: The Categories

Something for everyone



Hospitality, Leisure & Tourism Award

sponsored by Huffkins

Open to any hotel, restaurant, café, coffee shop, pub, leisure facility, visitor attraction or similar business irrespective of size.



Retail Award

sponsored by NFU Mutual

Open to any independent retail business regardless of size that can demonstrate good business performance.



Charity Award

sponsored by The Rooflight Company

Open to any charity or social enterprise based in West Oxfordshire regardless of size.



Marketing Excellence Award

sponsored by First Sight Media

Open to any organisation irrespective of size or industry sector that has run a marketing campaign.



Innovation Award

sponsored by Owen Mumford

Open to any organisation, irrespective of size or industry sector that can demonstrate an innovation that creates value, whether a product, a system or a process.



Employer of the Year Award

Open to businesses of any size that can demonstrate why they are a good employer, from work culture to training, leadership to apprenticeships.



New Business Award

Open to any business that started trading after 1st January 2015 that has traded for at least 12 months showing how you have achieved success to date.



Micro Business Award

Open to any business that employs fewer than 5 staff. This includes the business owner, where the owner works within the business.



Small Business Award

Open to any business that employs between 5 and 25 staff.



Large Business Award

Open to any business that employs more than 25 staff or has an annual turnover of over £3million.



Business Person of the Year Award

Open to individuals who have worked to the benefit of the organisation for over 5 years, usually owners/ directors.

West Oxfordshire Business of the Year

sponsored by STL Communications

Selected by the judges from the winners of the other categories, the award is presented to the business that best represents West Oxfordshire in terms of its success, commitment to the local area, contribution to the local economy and role as an ambassador representing West Oxfordshire on a wider stage. The winner of the prestigious title **West Oxfordshire Business of the Year** receives a specially commissioned trophy designed by students from Abingdon & Witney College and crafted by Synolos.



Cally Robson Award

This award is presented by the WOBA Team to the business that best reflects the values of their late colleague Cally Robson, namely entrepreneurship, innovation and an ingrained sense of the community. There is no entry form for this award – the winner is selected from the WOBA finalists.

Why enter again?

Whilst some WOBA winners make it at their first attempt, many don't succeed first time around. If you've entered before and not made the shortlist or been a finalist, then try again. It's amazing the difference a year can make and you might win!

Why enter more than one category?

Once you've written an entry for one category, it's easy to amend it to fit other categories and with entry being free, it makes sense to enter as many categories as you can to give you the best chance of picking up a WOBA. Enter one of the size-based categories and then look at the more specific ones.

Why encourage others to enter?

If you are a marketing agency, business coach or an accountant, encourage your clients to enter and help them to celebrate their growth or business success. Or if you know a great West Oxfordshire business that you think could be a WOBA winner, get them to enter.



Who can enter?

As long as your business is based in West Oxfordshire you can enter
